The Lifetime Achievement Awards an important and another touching award to show some recognition for our horse companions who have sadly passed away during the previous competitive season - these always deserve to be remembered. This year we have four such companions those being

<u>Cliquot of Scaleby</u> who belonged to Amanda Crompton a relative newcomer to endurance, but who completed 519 kms in her endurance career.

Secondly **Roxie** who was Sara Kavanagher's companion and who completed 711kms in her career.

Thirdly we have <u>Elina of Rushbank</u> who was Helen Dawson's horse partner who completed 2724kms in her endurance life in both competitive and non-competitive events.

<u>Rassam</u> - who belonged to Anne Booth and completed 4730km in mainly competitive events.

Additionally, these Lifetime Achievement Awards were designed to be awarded not only to deceased horses, but also to those who are now permanently retired from their endurance careers. These can only be claimed if this is genuine permanent retirement, and such horses will not be able to claim any mileage or awards in the future. Two such this year are

Calean Joy better known as Sonny, owned by Carolyn Cummings who is now retired at the age of 28 - and who completed 7782 kms.

And Crystal's Opal Moon or Blodwyn owned by Sue Taylor-Green, who at 29years old has been retired for a couple of years now. Blodwyn completed 847 kms.
